Diagnosis: Left front fetlock dorsomedial PI chip fracture.

Diagnostic Procedures and Finds:
Physical exam, bloodwork, radiographs.

Prognosis: Favorable.

Surgery: Arthroscopic removal.

Date of Surgery: 06/22/07

Treatment: Potassium penicillin, gentocin, phenylbutazone, tetanus toxoid.

Recommendations and Instructions:

1. 2 weeks stall rest followed by 3 weeks stall rest and hand walking. If doing well after 5 weeks, gradually resume normal care.
2. Bute 1.0g orally, twice daily for 10 days post-operatively.
3. Adequan 1 vial IM or Polyglycan 5cc IV once a week for 5 weeks beginning 1 week after surgery.
4. Remove Steri-strips in 10-12 days. There are no sutures to be removed.
5. Bandage for 30 days, changing every other day or as needed.
