Footnotes

HAINESPORT was well placed in the three path for a half, closed the gap on the turn, opened a clear lead nearing the furlong marker and held off the runner-up under steady left hand urging. PRESS ONLY was taken in hand on the first turn, was rated along the rail for six furlongs, launched a rally along the fence entering the stretch and finished willingly along the inside but could not get up. NEW YORK HOLIDAY set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and weakened. INTERFERENCE broke awkwardly, trailed inside to the turn, swung wide and failed to threaten. POWERFUL STORM raced in good position for five furlongs, split horses while rallying three wide on the turn and flattened out. TAKE A LEAP saved ground to no avail. SABLE ISLAND steadied inside the winner on the first turn, was in hand along the backstretch, waited in traffic on the far turn and steadily tired thereafter. GOLDEN FUSAICHI pressed the pace for five furlongs and faltered.
