Footnotes

COSMIC tracked the dueling leader along the inside, slipped through to make his bid, forged command with three furlongs to run, edged clear entering the stretch, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of HARLEM ROCKER and was fully extended to just last. HARLEM ROCKER settled in hand off of the inside while never far back, angled out to make his move, came four wide, finished well and was getting to the winner with every stride. AGASTACHE dueled for the lead three wide, kept on willingly through a long drive but was unable to match strides with the top two late. MUTADDA was unhurried into stride, ranged into striking distance four wide, offered a mild bid but lacked the needed late kick. SUCCESS SUCCESS settled saving ground, angled out four wide and improved his position through the stretch. CASSOULET stalked the pace four wide, made a middle move from between horses, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. KING OF THE ROXY contended between horses, settled off of the pace toward the inside through the turn, but came up empty after a half and dropped out. TIMBUCTO disputed the pace off of the inside, was collared between horses after a half and gave way readily once headed.
