Footnotes

CLASS BOPPER rated within range while saving ground, angled out four wide into the lane, rallied past the dueling leaders leaving the three sixteenths marker and kicked clear under a drive. INVISIBLE GENIUS prompted the pace two wide, moved to near even terms leaving the far turn, dueled to upper stretch, drifted out but stayed on well to be well clear of the rest. HOT BULLET settled inside down the backstretch, angled out leaving the far turn, came three wide for the drive, angled to the rail leaving the three sixteenths marker and finished with good energy. INTERROGATORY gained command between rivals nearing the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled from the three eighths pole to upper stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. JOGGER was steadied nearing the first turn, angled out three wide soon after, continued wide to the lane and finished willingly. ITALIAN WEDDING , five wide into the first turn, raced three wide past the half mile pole and lacked a solid response. J STORM , five wide early, had some belated interest between rivals. PORCUPINE was carried out six wide early. SAY HALLELUJAH saved ground, raced forwardly to the far turn and weakened. BOXER SHORTS was steadied nearing the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail and tired leaving the three sixteenths marker. PLEASANT TOP , four wide early, was not a factor. UNCONSTRAINED broke slowly and was outrun. SLOUIS , a bit rank early, raced off the rail and dropped back.
