BANK OF DAD rated off the duel along the rail through the opening half, eased off the rail to advance leaving the three-eighths pole, came three wide to bid inside of GOLDEN DYNASTY near the five-sixteenths pole, took command in upper stretch, drew off under a drive and held clear under confident handling late. GOLDEN DYNASTY was unhurried while racing three wide through the opening half, advanced leaving the three-eighths pole, bid four wide just outside the winner near the five-sixteenths marker, could not match strides with that rival in upper stretch but finished willingly for the place. KAUFY BIG SHOT dueled two wide through the opening three-quarters, could not resist the top two in upper stretch but held well to save the show. OSTIN'S MIRACLE was devoid of speed while saving ground through the first six furlongs, steadily angled to the far outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. STAYONIT dueled along the rail for three-quarters and tired. COMMANDER BAY stalked the pace two and three wide and faltered.
