INDIAN RESERVATION rated with the pace two deep, moved to the lead approaching the final turn, drew clear entering the stretch and held on well under steady handling. CHAMP DE MARS rated off the pace outside, started his drive toward the quarter pole, closed to deep stretch then just lasted in place. MILWAUKEE CHIEF rated back off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole, eased out entering the stretch and was closing strong late. COLONIAL LEGACY rated a slim lead inside, contested the final turn, lost ground entering the stretch and weakened. AWESOME CHARLIE rated close off the rail, gave chase toward the final turn then weakened through the turn. CONTENDERE was through after half. SIR PRIZE U, shuffled back early, was never a factor. HOT BULLET lost contact early.
