EMPIRE RISING settled off the early pace, gained and moved into contention from the five path turning for home, rallied strong from there, took command and went clear. GIGANTOS outside foes in the early going, closed and bid four wide turning for home, led into mid stretch then was outfinished to the wire. PERFECT CHEROKEE stalked the pacesetters, bid from the four path into the stretch after angling out, then angled out for clear sailing in the run to the wire and finished off a good effort. MIAMI DECO made an early move and was three wide and dueling into the far turn, vied into the stretch from there then tired inside foes in the drive. SCRAM DIGGITY tracked the early leader then went up to press from between foes, vied on the far turn then faltered. BEAR IN CONTROL had speed to lead the way out of the clubhouse turn and opened a gap, was challenged into the far turn, vied inside into the stretch then faded. SARATOGA THUNDER saved ground on the far turn while trailing then failed to bid. HOLY KNIGHT off the pace, bolted going into the far turn, was pulled up and did not finish.
