SANGORE stalked the pacesetters then angled out for the stretch run and bid four wide, rallied strong and was clear at the wire. PRIZED HUMOUR chased the speed and was outside the front runner and bidding turning for home then outgunned to the wire. FREE TO FLY came from well back to put in a strong belated stretch run and finished well. COLD HARBOR had an outside trip that lacked a final kick. GAZUMBA never far back and a factor pressing for the lead turning for home, gave way. MONTROSE AVENUE had inside speed, led through the turn then tired. PAYNES GOLD was off the pace then lacked the needed rally. CARLTON BEACH in pack and between foes early, failed to fire.
