GAZUMBA raced off the pace, chased six-wide into the stretch, rallied and got by late under a hand ride. DUKES ALLEY raced midpack, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn, rallied but was outkicked in the final 16th. BLUSHING BRAT led late backstretch, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch but failed to stay. DEACONS FARM raced off the pace, chased eight-wide into the stretch and finished all out. SIX SHOOTER showed early speed, chased five-wide on the turn then flattened out midstretch. NAFTA raced forwardly, forced the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. CRAFTY MCNABB raced midpack, came four to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but lacked a closing response. CALM NIGHT raced off the pace, closed inside rivals on the turn, then tired upper stretch. DESTINED TO SHINE had early speed between foes, gave way nearing the turn then faded under a ride.
